DECLARATION ON RADIOPHARMACEUTICALS SANCTION

Unfortunately, based on the information existed, Pars Isotope Company, the only supplier of radiopharmaceuticals (radioactive drugs) used in Iran medical centers, has been recently sanctioned by the United States Department of the Treasury. This anti-human being action will be resulted in the cease in radioactive drugs based diagnosis activities in more than 180 nuclear medical centers in Iran which provide services to more than 1 million patients a year and this is against the fact that drugs and agricultural items are expressed excluded in the list of the sanctions.

The clear cut point is that radioactive drugs sanctions will cause irrevocable damages to the patients and this is clearly against the humanity principles and human rights.

Condemning this anti humanity action, the Iranian Society of Nuclear Medicine expects the international bodies and the alleging human rights foundations to take the serious actions on lifting the radiopharmaceuticals sanctions.
